How to remove your name from old voter rolls

Iowa

Instructions

- Step 1:** Confirm your voter registration on the state or county website:
<https://sos.iowa.gov/elections/voterreg/regtovote/search.aspx>
- Step 2:** Notify the state or county that you should no longer be registered. Different locations have different removal processes. Here's what we found for Iowa:
 - You must contact the **county auditor where you were previously registered**.*
 - Provide a written letter with an explanation for your removal with the necessary information required by that county.*
 - According to the SOS office representative, the county auditor sends this information to the SOS and the voter rolls are cleaned annually.*
- Step 3:** Mark your calendar to follow up in 30 days. If your voter registration status is still active, recontact the registration office.

FAQs

What information is required for my removal?

Send a letter with an explanation for removal to the county auditor with your:

Name, DOB, former address, handwritten signature for verification purposes

What if I don't remember my information?

The county auditor will be able to assist you.

What if I need to remove a deceased family member?

The county auditor will instruct you on what is required, but in all cases you will need to provide proof of death.
