How to remove your name from old voter rolls

Idaho

Instructions

- **Step 1:** Confirm your voter registration on the state or county website: <https://elections.sos.idaho.gov/ElectionLink/ElectionLink/VoterSearch.aspx>
- **Step 2:** Notify the state/county that you should no longer be registered. Different locations have different removal processes. Here's what we found for Idaho:
 - Idaho voter registration cancellations must be made at the county level. Some counties offer their own cancellation form.
 - Call the county in which you used to be registered (find your county here: <https://voteidaho.gov/county-clerk/>)
 - Provide the necessary information your county asks for and request for your name to be removed from the voter roll
- **Step 3:** Mark your calendar to follow up in 30 days. If your registration hasn't been removed, recontact the registration office.

FAQs

What information is required for my removal?

Every county in OR may have a different standard of required information to remove your name from the voter roll. Common information needed is full name, DOB, last four digits of SSN, address or zip code used when you registered in that county, and/or a handwritten signature for verification purposes.

What if I need to remove a deceased family member?

The county clerk will instruct you on what is required, but in all cases you will need to provide proof of death.
