How to remove your name from old voter rolls

Kansas

Instructions

- Step 1:** Confirm your voter registration on the state or county website:
<https://myvoteinfo.voteks.org/VoterView/>
- Step 2:** Notify the state or county that you should no longer be registered. Different locations have different removal processes. Here's what we found for Kansas:
 - You must contact the **election county official in the county where you were previously registered.***
 - Provide as much identifying information as possible.*
 - Ask for confirmation of removal request.*
- Step 3:** Mark your calendar to follow up in 30 days. If your registration hasn't been removed, recontact the registration office.

FAQs

What information is required for my removal?

According to the SOS Elections Division, there are no specific requirements, however, they ask for as much identifying information as possible. For example, provide a typed or handwritten letter stating you wish to be removed from the voter roll to the election county official with your:

Full name, DOB, address used when you registered in that county, last four digits of your SSN, etc.

What if I don't remember my information?

Because there are no specific requirements, they only ask for as much identifying information as possible.

What if I need to remove a deceased family member?

The county clerk will instruct you on what is required, but in all cases you will need to provide proof of death.
