## RE: Public Records Request dated October 13, 2025

Dear Meg Denning/True the Vote:

You made a request under Wisconsin Public Records Law to the Waukesha County Clerk. Your request, sent via email was dated and received 10/13/25. I am the designated Records Custodian for the Office of the Waukesha County Clerk. Public Records requests are governed by Wis. Stat. § 19.31-19.39, as well as other relevant prevailing and applicable law. Your request seeks the following:

"This request seeks all records, communications, directives, or guidance created or received by your office since March 25, 2025, related to Executive Order 14248, titled \*'Preserving and Protecting the Integrity of American Elections'\*, including but not limited to:

- 1. Actions taken or planned to comply with, respond to, or evaluate the order;
- 2. Communications with federal agencies (including the Election Assistance Commission or Department of Justice) concerning implementation or challenges to the order;
- 3. Any internal analyses, meeting notes, or correspondence with county officials, election vendors, or other stakeholders related to voter roll verification, mail-ballot receipt deadlines, or documentary proof-of-citizenship requirements.

Additionally, please include any records, guidance, or communications your office has sent to counties or local election authorities in connection with Executive Order 14248."

After examination I have found no responsive records exist in the County Clerk's Office.

Please be advised Wis. Stat. § 19.35(4)(b) provides that determinations made by a records custodian are subject to review by mandamus under Wis. Stat. § 19.37(1), or upon application to the attorney general or district attorney.
